The successful candidate will be expected to assume the responsibility of a regional representative of a bargaining agent under the Canada Labour Code and the Public Service Labour Relations Act. Duties will include interpreting and negotiating collective agreements, organizing new bargaining groups, representing members in disputes with employers, and providing information and assistance to members regarding training, employment, certification, regulatory issues and safety. The Guild represents over 4000 ship's officers and marine pilots across the country.

Candidates will need to demonstrate a good working knowledge of legislation and regulations applicable to Guild members in Atlantic Canada.

A positive attitude, strong communication skills, and a commitment to providing high-calibre service are essential requirements.
