Worked Example of Calculation of Revised GSO Wage Increase

We have been asked to provide a worked example of how to calculate the REVISED wage increase for GSO's that will come into effect after midnight on March 31st, 2010.

Appendix H Officers

The rate of pay on March 31st, 2010 for an MAO-6 on <u>layday rate of pay</u> is 71,964. per year. The rate of pay for an MAO-6 on April 1st, 2010 is 35.00 per hour x 42 hours per week x 52.176 weeks per year equals 76,699. per year, which is an increase of 6.58%. There is some minor rounding off as usual in the pay scales, but the <u>layday pay rates</u> go up by at least 6.55% on that date.

Appendix I, J & K Officers

The conventional rate of pay for an MAO-6 on March 31st, 2010 is 30.58 per hour. The rate of pay for an MAO-6 on April 1st, 2010 is 35.00 per hour. This is an increase of 14.45%. (Multiply hourly rate by 40 hours per week x 52.176 weeks per year to obtain annual salary for conventional pay system.) Once again, there is some minor rounding off as usual in the pay scales, but the conventional pay rates go up by at least 14.4% on that date.
